

*Ladies Lace Detail Jumper*  
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## JUMPER WITH COLLAR AND IN-SET OF WOOL LACE.

**MATERIALS:** 8 ozs of "MILADI ANNE" 3 ply in main shade. 1 oz "MILADI ANNE" 3 ply in contrast. 1 pair each Nos. 11 and 12 "PARAGON" knitting needles. 1 medium crochet hook. 3 small buttons.

**MEASUREMENTS:** Length from shoulder 20½ins (21½ins). Sleeve seam 12ins (12½ins). Bust 34ins (36ins).

**TENSION:** 15 sts and 23 rows to 2ins.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** K, knit; p, purl; sts, stitches; inc, increase; dec, decrease; ins, inches; stst, stocking stitch (right side k, wrong side p); tog, together; beg, beginning; rep, repeat; m 1, make 1 (by bringing or leaving the wool forward before a k st, or winding the wool around the needle before a p st), cont, continue; rem, remains(ing); rsf, right side facing; M, main shade, C, contrast.

**THE BACK:** Using No. 11 needles and M wool cast on 125 (133) sts and work ¾ inch in stst, ending with a p row. P the next row to form a hemline, then work 1 inch in stst (next row p). Now dec 1 st at both ends of the next and every following 4th row until 111 (119) sts rem. Cont without further shaping until work measures 3½ (4) ins from hemline. Work 1 row, working tog every 9th and 10th st across the row. 100 (108) sts. Change to No. 12 needles and work 2ins in k 1, p 1 rib, inc into the 1st and every following 7th st on the last rib row for the 1st size and into every 7th st on the last rib row for the 2nd size. 115 (123) sts. Change to No. 11 needles and cont in stst, inc 1 st at both ends of every 8th row until there are 131 (139) sts on the needle, then work straight until work measures 12½ (13½) ins from hemline.

**SHAPE ARMHOLES:** Cast off 7 (7) sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of every alternate row 6 (7) times, 105 (111) sts. Work without further shaping until armhole measures 5½ins on the straight, ending with a p row. Now work for the back opening as follows:—

**Next row:** K 52 (55), place rem sts on a spare needle and leave until required. Cont on these sts until armhole measures 7½ins on the straight.

**SHAPE SHOULDER:** Cast off 8 (7) sts from armhole edge on the next 4 (5) alternate rows. Cast off rem sts. Rejoin wool to sts on spare needle, work 2 tog, then work to correspond with opposite side, reversing shapings.

**THE FRONT:** Work exactly as given for back until there are 129 (137) sts on the needle. P 1 row.

**Next row:** K 64 (68), cast off 1 st, k 64 (68).

**Next row:** P 62 (66), p 2 tog. Place rem sts on a spare needle and leave until required. Cont on these sts as follows:—Dec 1 st at centre edge on every row until 57 (61) sts rem. On the next row, inc 1 st at side edge and dec 1 st at centre edge.

Now, keeping side edge straight, cont to dec 1 st at centre edge on every row until 47 (51) sts rem. Work (if necessary) until work measures same as for back to armholes, ending with a k row.

**SHAPE ARMHOLES:** Still cont to dec 1 st at centre edge on every row, cast off 7 sts at armhole edge on the next row, then dec 1 st at armhole edge on the next 6 (7) alternate rows. Keeping armhole edge straight, cont to dec at centre edge until all sts have been worked off. Rejoin wool to sts on spare needle and work the other side to correspond.

**YOKE:** Cast on 1 st, and work in stst, inc 1 st at both ends of every row until there are 105 (111) sts on the needle, then work 18 rows without shaping.

**SHAPE NECK:** K 42 (45) cast off 21, place rem sts on a spare needle and cont on these sts as follows:—Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next 5 rows, then dec 1 st at neck edge on the next 5 alternate rows. Cont without further shaping until side edge measures 3½ins.

**SHAPE SHOULDER:** Cast off 8 (7) sts from armhole edge on every alternate row 4 (5) times. Rejoin wool to sts on spare needle and work the other side to correspond.

**SLEEVES:** Using No. 11 needles cast on 88 sts and work in stst for 2ins, ending with a p row. P 1 row to form a hemline, then cont in stst (next row p), inc 1 st at both ends of the needle at intervals of 2½ins until there are 94 (96) sts. Now cont without further shaping until sleeve measures 12 (12½) ins.

**SHAPE TOP:** Cast off 7 sts at the beg of the next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 6 (7) alternate rows, then dec 1 st at both ends of every

4th row 6 times. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 6 alternate rows, then dec 1 st at both ends of the next 10 rows. Cast off rem sts.

**FRONT INSERTIONS:** Press both parts of front carefully with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Now take the top yoke, and with rsf and using No. 11 needles and M wool start at side edge and pick up and k 67 sts to centre point, pick up 1 st at centre, then pick up and k 67 sts along other side edge (135 sts). Now join on C wool and p 3 rows, making 1 st before and after centre st on the 1st and 3rd rows (139 sts).

**4th row:** K 1, \* (k 2 tog) twice, wool forward, k into back of next st) 3 times, wool forward (pass needle through next st as though to k it, then k into the back of next st and let both loops fall from left hand needle) twice, \* rep from \* to \* 5 times, k 5, rep from \* to \* 6 times, k 1.

**5th row:** P 69, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 69.

**6th row:** P.

**7th row:** P 70, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 70.

**8th row:** K 1, rep from \* to \* as on 4th row 6 times, k 9; rep from \* to \* 6 times, k 1.

**9th row:** P 71, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 71.

**10th row:** P.

**11th row:** P 72, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 72.

**12th row:** K 1, rep from \* to \* as 4th row 6 times, k 13, rep from \* to \* as 4th row 6 times, k 1.

**13th row:** P 73, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 73.

**14th row:** P.

**15th row:** P 74, m 1, p 1, m 1, p 74.

Cast off purlwise.

**COLLAR:** Using No. 11 needles and C wool cast on 70 sts and work as follows:—

**1st and 2nd rows:** P.

**3rd row:** K 2, rep from \* to \* as on 4th row of insertion 6 times, k 2.

**Next 3 rows:** K 2, p to last 2 sts, k 2.

**7th row:** As the 3rd row.

**Next 3 rows:** K 2, p to last 2 sts, k 2.

**11th row:** As the 3rd row.

**Next 3 rows:** K 2, p to last 2 sts, k 2.

Cast off purlwise. Work 2nd part of collar to correspond.

**TO MAKE UP:** Press rem part of jumper carefully with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Pin contrast insertions to edge of shaped front of jumper and sew into place. Now join side, shoulder and sleeve seams. Sew in sleeves. Using M wool, work 2 rows of double crochet round back opening, making 3 loops for button-holes on 2nd row on right side. Sew on buttons to correspond with loops. Sew on collar. Press all seams.
