

*Lace Twin Set*  
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**MATERIALS:** 11 ozs "Miladi Anne" Botany 2 ply, 1 pair each Nos 13 and 11 "Paragon" knitting needles, 8 buttons, 1 set of No 13 double-pointed needles.

**MEASUREMENTS:** Jumper: Length from shoulder 20½ ins. Sleeve seam 6½ ins. Cardigan: Length from shoulder 21 ins. Sleeve seam 18 ins. Bust: 38-40 ins.

**ABBREVIATIONS:** K, knit; p, purl; sts, stitches; inc, increase; dec, decrease; beg, beginning; rep, repeat; patt, pattern; m 1, make 1 (by bringing or leaving the wool forward before a k st or winding the wool around the needle before a p st); sl, slip; tog, together; pss0, pass slipped stitch over; rsf, right side facing; rem, remains (ing); cont, continue; ins, inches.

#### THE JUMPER.

**The Back:** Using no 13 needles cast on 120 sts. Work in k 1, p 1 rib for 3 ins inc into every 40th st on the last row. (123 sts). Change to No 11 needles and work in patt as follows:—

1st row: K 1, sl 1, k 1, pss0; \* m 1, k 1, m 1, sl 1, k 2 tog, pss0; rep from \* until 4 sts rem, m 1, k 1, m 1, sl 1, k 1, pss0, k 1.

2nd and every alternate row: P

3rd row: K 1, k 2 tog, \* m 1, k 5, m 1, sl 1, k 2 tog, pss0; rep from \* until 3 sts rem, m 1, sl 1, k 1, pss0, k 1.

5th row: As 3rd row.

7th row: \* k 3, m 1, sl 1, k 1, pss0, k 1, k 2 tog, m 1; rep from \* until 3 sts rem, k 3.

8th row: As 2nd row.

These 8 rows form the patt, cont to rep them inc 1 st at both ends of needle in the next and very following 4th row until there are 139 sts on the needle, working the extra sts into patt as they become available. Cont without further shaping until piece measures 12½ ins from commencement.

**Shape Armholes:** (rsf) Keeping patt correct cast off 8 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec at both ends of every row until 107 sts rem. Cont in patt without further shaping until armholes measure 7½ ins on straight.

**Shape Shoulders:** Cast off 8 sts at beg of next 8 rows. Change to No 13 needles and work in k 1, p 1, rib on rem back neck sts for 1 inch. Cast off.

**The Front:** Work as for back until armholes measure 4½ ins on the straight ending with a wrong side row.

**Shape Neck:** Patt across 32 sts turn, and cont on these 32 sts until armhole measures same as for back to shoulder.

**Shape Shoulders:** Cast off 8 sts at armhole edge on the next 4 alternate rows. Now place the next 43 sts on a spare needle and leave until required. Join wool at neck edge and work on rem 32 sts to correspond with other side.

**Neckband:** Using No 13 double-pointed needles and with rsf work as follows:—1st needle: pick up and k 40 sts down left side of neck. 2nd needle: K the 43 sts from spare needle. 3rd needle: pick up and k 40 sts up right side of neck.

1st row: Work in k 1, p 1 rib across all 3 needles.

2nd row: 1st needle: Rib to the last 2 sts, work 2 tog. 2nd needle: Work 2 tog, rib to last 2 sts, work 2 tog. 3rd needle: Work 2 tog, rib to end. Cont to rep these 2 rows until ribbing measures 1 inch. Cast off.

**The Sleeves:** (Both alike). Using No 13 needles cast on 88 sts and work in k 1, p 1 rib for 1½ ins, inc into every 8th st on the last row. (99sts). Change to No 11 needles and work in patt as for back until piece measures 6½ ins from beg.

**Shape Top:** Dec 1 st at the beg of the next 8 rows, then dec at both ends of every row until 13 sts rem. Cast off.

#### THE CARDIGAN

**The Back:** Using No 13 needles, cast on 122 sts and work 3½ ins in k 1, p 1 rib, inc into every 13th st on last row. (131 sts.) Change to No 11 needles and work 1 complete patt. Cont in patt inc 1 st at each end of the needle in the next and every following 4th row, until there are 147 sts on needle. Cont without further shaping until work measures 13 ins from commencement.

**Shape Armholes:** (rsf) Cast off 8 sts at beg of next 2 rows, then dec at both ends of every row until 107 sts rem. Work without further shaping until armholes measure 7½ ins on the straight ending with a wrong side row.

**Shape Shoulders:** Cast off 8 sts at the beg of next 8 rows. Cast off rem sts for back neck.

**Left Front:** Using No 13 needles cast on 64 sts and work in k 1, p 1 rib for 3½ ins, inc into every 21st st on last row. (67 sts). Change to No 11 needles and work 1 complete patt. Cont in patt inc 1 st at armhole edge on the next and every following 4th row until there are 75 sts on the needle. Cont without further shaping until work measures same as for back to armhole.

**Shape Armhole:** (rsf) Cast off 8 sts at the beg of the next row, then dec 1 st at this edge in every row until there are 59 sts on needle. Now dec 1 st at neck edge in every 3rd row until 35 sts rem. Work if necessary until armhole measures same as for back to shoulder.

**Shape Shoulder:** (rsf) Cast off 8 sts at the beg of the next and every alternate row until 11 sts rem. Work 1 row, then cast of rem sts.

**Right Front.** Work as for left front with all shapings reversed.

**The Sleeves:** Using No 13 needles, cast on 63 sts and work in k 1, p 1 rib for 2 ins, dec 1 st at end of the last row. (67 sts). Change to No 11 needles and work in patt inc 1 st at both ends of the needle in the 5th and every following 6th row until there are 107 sts on the needle. Cont without further shaping until sleeve measures 18 ins or required length.

**Shape Top:** Shape as directions for shaping top of short sleeves.

**The Strapping:** Using No 13 needles cast on 14 sts. Work 4 rows in k 1, p 1 rib, then make a buttonhole in the next row as follows:—Rib 4, cast off 6, rib 4. On the following row cast on 6 sts to replace those cast

off. Work 5 more buttonholes approximately 2½ ins apart. Cont in rib until the strapping is long enough to fit around the front and neck edges (slightly stretched) cast off.

**To Make Up:** Press the work very lightly on the wrong side with a warm iron over a damp cloth omitting ribbing. The jumper: Sew side, sleeve and 2 inches of each shoulder seam of jumper. Sew in sleeves. Work 1 button loop each side of front neck. The Cardigan: Sew shoulder seams, slightly easing front to back. Sew side and sleeve seams of cardigan. Sew in sleeves. Sew strapping to front edges. Press seams. Sew buttons to back neck of jumper. Sew buttons on cardigan to correspond with buttonholes.
